It is an honor to submit the Illinois Community College Board and Illinois Board of Higher Education's comprehensive plan to scale developmental education to the General Assembly. The Illinois Community College Board and the Illinois Board of Higher Education are committed to maximizing the number of students who complete credit-bearing certificate programs and two-year or four-year degree programs and entering high-skill, high-wage occupations.

Senate Joint Resolution 41 required that an Advisory Council be created and that the Advisory Council deliver a "detailed plan for scaling developmental education reforms," to the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB), the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE), and the General Assembly (GA), by July 1, 2020. This report is the result of that requirement
