> Re: Mandatory 5 Year Reporting -Business Assistance and Regulatory Reform Act

To whom it may concern:

The Business Assistance and Regulatory Reform Act (20 ILCS 608/20) mandates that all Illinois state agencies submit a report every five years beginning in 2017 and include any result and recommendation following a review of the agency's rules, regulations and permitting processes applicable to small businesses. The report is to be submitted to the DCEO, the Governor's Office and the General Assembly. This letter is the Illinois Independent Tax Tribunal's 2022 report.

The Illinois Independent Tax Tribunal is a state agency whose sole function is to operate an administrative law court to handle disputes between the Illinois Department of Revenue and taxpayers. The Tax Tribunal is not involved in any small business permitting process and, as a result, does not have any results or recommendations to report.
