October 16, 2012

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 11, 2012 MEETING

Representative Lang moved, seconded by Representative Thapedi, to approve the minutes of the September 11, 2012 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

REVIEW OF AGENCY RULEMAKINGS

Department of Public Health – Perinatal HIV Prevention Code (77 Ill. Adm. Code 699; 36 Ill. Reg. 2060)

Senator Harmon moved, seconded by Senator Althoff, that JCAR and DPH agree to extend this rulemakings for an additional 45 days to address issues raised by public commentors. DPH had expressed its concurrence in advance. The motion passed unanimously.

CONSIDERATION OF OTHER RULEMAKINGS

Co-Chair Saviano asked if any members requested consideration of any other rulemaking. Representative Lang requested consideration of a CDB rulemaking.

Capital Development Board – Illinois Energy Conservation Code (71 Ill. Adm. Code 600; 36 Ill. Reg. 6784)

Representative Lang moved, seconded by Representative Moffitt, that JCAR and CDB agree to extend this rulemakings for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously.

Lisa Mattingly, CDB Administrator, was present and agreed to the Extension.

Representative Harris moved, seconded by Senator Althoff, that the Committee inform the agencies to whose rulemakings the Committee did not vote an Objection or an Extension, or did not remove from the No Objection List, that the Committee considered their respective rulemakings at the monthly meeting and, based upon the Agreements for modification of the rulemakings made by the agencies, no Objections will be issued. The motion passed unanimously.

Department of Healthcare and Family Services – Medical Payment (89 Ill. Adm. Code 140; 36 Ill. Reg. 11329) (Emergency) and Hospital Services (89 Ill. Adm. Code 148; 36 Ill. Reg. 10326) (Emergency)
