

*Illinois Regulation is a summary of the weekly regulatory decisions of State agencies published in the Illinois Register and action taken by the Illinois General Assembly's Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Illinois Regulation, also titled The Flinn Report in memory of founding JCAR member Rep. Monroe Flinn, is designed to inform and involve the public in changes taking place in agency administration.*

## Proposed Rulemakings

### ■ GRANT APPLICATIONS

The OFFICE OF THE TREASURER proposed amendments to Rules for Charitable Trust Stabilization Committee (74 IAC 650; 41 Ill Reg 10322) updating the grant application process for the Charitable Trust Stabilization Program, which awards grants to community-based organizations and non-profits. Applicants must now submit a Certificate of Good Standing from the Office of the Illinois Secretary of State. Other documentation showing that the applicant is currently registered with the Illinois Attorney General's Charitable Trust Bureau may be submitted in lieu of a Form CO-1 Charitable Organization Registration Statement. A separate financial statement is no longer required. Applications may be submitted online via the Treasurer's website, as well as by mail.

### TAXPAYER RIGHTS

The DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE proposed an amendment to Taxpayer Rights (86 IAC 205; 41 Ill Reg 10328) repealing a Section outlining the responsibilities of DOR's taxpayer ombudsman because the statute authorizing that office is no longer in effect.

## New Rules

### AABD BENEFITS

The DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES adopted amendments to Aid to the Aged, Blind or Disabled (89 IAC 113; 41 Ill Reg 2343), effective 7/21/17, implementing an annual adjustment in the Supplemental Security Income allowance and in the AABD rates for sheltered, personal and nursing care. All rates are being increased \$2 per month, reflecting the January 2017 increase in SSI.

**PEREMPTORY RULES:** Rules adopted without prior public notice or JCAR review as authorized by 5 ILCS 100/5-50.  
■ Designates rules of special interest to small businesses, small municipalities, and not-for-profit corporations. Agencies are required to consider comments from these groups and minimize the regulatory burden on them.
