- S.J.R. 89 -- Wilhelmi --- Provides that the National Organization on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Illinois (NOFAS ILLINOIS) will provide free educational pamphlets concerning fetal alcohol syndrome to the county clerks for distribution to marriage license applicants. Calls for NOFAS Illinois and the county clerks to determine the best way to ensure distribution.

Messages from the Senate

S.J.R. 112 -- Kotowski - Garrett --- Extends the reporting date for the task force concerning student health needs established pursuant to House Joint Resolution 46 of the 96th General Assembly from January 1, 2010 to March 1, 2011. Adds representatives from the Epilepsy Foundations of Greater Chicago and North/Central Illinois as members of the task force.

S.J.R. 115 -- Maloney --- Creates the Interdependence of Generations Task Force to: study and make recommendations regarding the creative ways that aging, education, and other public and private organizations can work together; and issue a report no later than December 31, 2010.

S.J.R. 117 -- **(Gordon, Jehan)** Koehler --- Expresses the General Assembly's support for the Illinois Alzheimer's Disease and Other Related Dementia State Plan as a blueprint going forward in the fight against Alzheimer's disease.

Constitutional Amendments Second Reading

H.J.R.C.A. 37 -- Farnham - Sente --- Proposes to amend the Finance Article of the Illinois Constitution. Limits aggregate appropriations and transfers from the State's general funds in a fiscal year to the aggregate appropriations and transfers in the previous fiscal year, as adjusted by the 5-year average annual change in per capita personal income. Allows the Governor to declare a fiscal emergency and the General Assembly, by a three-fifths vote, to exceed the limitation. Requires excess revenues to be deposited into budget stabilization funds, and allows certain excess funds to be refunded. Effective upon being declared adopted. **Short Debate (Read in Full a Second Time)**

H.J.R.C.A. 50 -- Madigan - Franks --- Proposes to amend the Executive Article of the Illinois Constitution. Eliminates the office of Lieutenant Governor, beginning with the term of office otherwise commencing in 2015. Effective upon being declared adopted. (Executive RBA) **(Read in Full a Second Time)**

H.J.R.C.A. 57 -- Madigan - Franks - Dunkin - Gordon, Careen - Lang --- Proposes to amend the Judiciary Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that a person must have been a licensed attorney-at-law for a minimum of ten years to be eligible to serve as a Circuit Judge, a minimum of twelve years to be eligible to serve as an Appellate Judge, and a minimum of fifteen years to be eligible to serve as a Supreme Court Judge, except that a person serving as a Judge on December 31, 2010 is not disqualified from completing the current term of office or seeking an additional term. Effective upon being declared adopted. **Short Debate (Read in Full a Third Time)**
