Provides that the Commission shall gather information, review studies, and identify areas of best practice with respect to how the criminal justice system should handle persons with behavioral health disorders including mental illness, substance use disorders, and intellectual disabilities. Provides that the Commission shall make its report to the General Assembly on or before February 1, 2016; and that the report of the Commission shall detail those findings and recommendations, including: (1) a diversion action plan to improve efforts to divert persons with behavioral health disorders including mental illness, substance use disorders, and intellectual disabilities to appropriate treatment or diversion program as an alternative to incarceration; (2) areas of best practice in this State and other states to expand the use of effective pre-booking and post-booking options for those with behavioral health disorders; and (3) a performance monitoring process to include baseline and post-implementation data for prevalence of persons with behavioral health disorders and intellectual disabilities in the State's criminal justice system, outcomes, and return on investment. Provides that the Commission shall dissolve on February 15, 2016. (Judiciary - Criminal RBA)

H.J.R. 58 -- Drury - Morrison - Cassidy - Fine - Gordon-Booth --- Urges the State Board of Education to reconsider its use of the PARCC exam as a way to test students' readiness for higher education and instead consider the use of alternative Common Core-based exams. (Elem Sec Ed School Curricu Policies RBA)

H.R. 11 -- Thapedi - Bellock - Stewart --- Asks Congress to pass Trade Promotion Authority and urges the United States Trade Representative to conclude the negotiations and recommend ratification of the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership also known as T-TIP. (International Trade & Commerce RBA)

A-H.R. 55 -- Ives - Durkin - Bellock - Breen - Sandack -- - Directs the Auditor General to conduct a performance audit of the State moneys provided to the College of DuPage in Fiscal Year 2011, Fiscal Year 2012, Fiscal Year 2013, and Fiscal Year 2014. (CA 1) (Community College Access & Afford. RBA)
