### 99th GENERAL ASSEMBLY STATE OF ILLINOIS Saturday, May 30, 2015

#### Order of Resolutions

- H.J.R. 78 -- Bennett --- Designates the section of U.S. Route 45 as it runs through the Village of Loda as the "Veterans of Loda Township Highway". (Transportation, Regulation, Roads RBA)
- H.J.R. 79 -- Bradley --- Designates the portion of Illinois Route 166 in Creal Springs that runs from White Street to Walnut Street as the "Clyde Robertson Memorial Highway". (Transportation, Regulation, Roads RBA)
- H.J.R. 80 -- Chapa LaVia --- Urges the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to create and distribute a survey for the purposes of identifying the main reasons for which Illinois residents choose to leave our State. Urges the Department to make a reasonable attempt to have former Illinois residents fill out this survey so as to understand their decision to move out and to utilize cost-free online survey websites to create an inexpensive survey of this kind. (Economic Development & Housing RBA)
- H.J.R. 81 -- Bryant --- Designates the portion of Illinois Route 149 East from U.S. Route 51 to the Jackson County Line as the "Veterans Memorial Highway". (Transportation, Regulation, Roads RBA)
- H.J.R. 82 -- Ford - Gordon-Booth - Davis, Monique - Flowers - Lilly --- Urges the Governor to approve the appropriations that will fund the Urban Weatherization Initiative and to consider those appropriations as a priority in the budget process. (Appropriations-Public Safety RBA)
- H.R. 531 -- Welch - Bradley - Guzzardi - Smiddy - Sims --- Urges the members of the General Assembly to not implement any cuts to State aid to municipalities unless those cuts are matched by equally proportionate reductions in fees for financial services paid by State agencies, including fees for all financial services, including cash management, investment management, and debt management. Urges all State agencies to request that the firms that provide them financial services reduce fees by an equally proportionate amount if the General Assembly cuts State aid to municipalities and to not make any payments to firms that refuse to reduce fees for financial services by the set amount until they have first met all of their other financial obligations, including fully funding public services and State aid to municipalities, paying workers, making pension fund contributions, and paying other legitimate bills. (Revenue & Finance RBA)
- S.J.R. 11 -- **(Andersson - Tryon)** McConnaughay --- Creates the Electronic Driver's License Task Force. (Transportation: Vehicles & Safety RBA)
