H.J.R.C.A. 26 -- Madigan - Currie --- Proposes to amend the Revenue Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that an additional income tax shall be imposed on individuals in an amount equal to 3% of the portion of the individual's income that is greater than \$1,000,000 for the taxable year.
