Order of Resolutions

H.J.R. 92 -- DeLuca --- Designates the portion of East End Avenue between the intersections of 26th Street and East End Avenue and Sauk Trail and East End Avenue in South Chicago Heights as Honorary Thomas Cellini Way. (Transportation, Regulation, Roads RBA)

H.J.R. 93 -- Moffitt - Verschoore - Harris, David - Phelps - Smiddy --- Designates the portion of Illinois Route 17 from the Henry/Mercer County Line to the Village of Viola as the CPL Bryant J. Luxmore Memorial Highway. (Transportation, Regulation, Roads RBA)

H.R. 659 -- Sullivan --- Designates September 19, 2015 as "Gymnastics Day" in the State of Illinois in support of National Gymnastics Day. (Human Services RBA)

H.R. 687 -- Bradley - Costello - Davidsmeyer - Bryant - Bourne --- Urges the United States Department of the Interior to provide a comment period of no less than 180 days for public participation in and comment on the proposed Draft Stream Protection Rule. (Public Utilities RBA)

Order of Resolutions

H.R. 707 -- Riley - Sims - Davis, William - Evans - Turner --- Rescinds the requests and statements made in House Resolution 548 of the 99th General Assembly and urges the Governor, the Illinois Department of Transportation, the City of Chicago, and the members of the Illinois congressional delegation to accept in its place the statements and requests contained herein. Urges Governor Rauner and the Illinois Department of Transportation to seek federal planning funds to help pay for this study and to consider all potential alternatives for a true high speed rail line that would complement all existing Amtrak services. Urges all State agencies to provide any and all assistance to the City of Chicago in implementing this crucial transportation project. Commends Chicago Mayor Rahm Emanuel for his commitment to building high speed train service between O'Hare International Airport and downtown Chicago and urges all State agencies to provide any and all assistance to the City of Chicago in implementing this crucial transportation project. Commends the Mayors and Village Presidents, Council of Governments, Chambers of Commerce, and south suburban legislators for their planning and foresight with projects like the proposed SouthEast Service Line and their commitment to high speed rail as a necessary part of their regional development plan. Calls upon Congress to return to their previous practice in Fiscal Year 2010 of appropriating \$2.5 billion in the annual federal budget for capital grants to states for high speed rail projects in order to help fund this high speed rail project. (Transportation, Regulation, Roads RBA)

H.R. 709 -- Ford --- Extends the reporting date for the Commission to Reform Child Care in Illinois, created by House Resolution 254 of the 99th General Assembly, to September 1, 2016. (Human Services RBA)

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
