S.B. 191 -- J. Cullerton - Collins --- AN ACT concerning liquor.

- S.J.R. 17 -- Harris --- Creates the Task Force on Modes of School Transportation for Elementary and Secondary Education. Sets forth the membership of the Task Force. Provides that the Task Force shall conduct a review of current State and federal law regarding the use of various modes to transport elementary and secondary education students and make recommendations to the State Board of Education and the General Assembly regarding safe transportation of the students, and shall present legislative and administrative recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly no later than December 15, 2017.
- S.J.R. 23 -- Rezin --- Designates Route 113 from Carbon Hill Road to Virginia Street in Coal City as the "Dennis M. Neary Memorial Highway".
- S.J.R. 59 -- Syverson Rezin --- Creates the Illinois Automated Dialing and Solicitation Task Force to review the Telephone Solicitations Act (815 ILCS 413/) and develop ideas to update the Act.
- S.J.R. 77 -- Castro --- The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency shall provide a written report on April 15 of each year that includes a summary of the projects it has funded, the amount expended for each, and the estimated level of NOx emission reductions.
