Condemns the deportation of individuals who were adopted into American homes and should have every expectation that their citizenship matches that of their adoptive parents. Welcomes legislation that will provide citizenship for all adult adoptees whose adoptive parents did not complete the naturalization process while they were children. (Adoption & Child Welfare RBA)
- H.J.R. 25 -- Meier --- Designates Illinois Route 143 as it travels from its intersection with Route 4 east through the City of Marine as the "Larry D. Mills Memorial Highway". (Transportation: Regulation, Roads RBA)

- H.R. 50 -- Bennett --- Condemns restrictive speech policies at institutions of higher education and urges those institutions with such policies in place to reverse their decisions. (Higher Education RBA)
