The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District 4 Act is amended by adding Section 57 as follows: 5 6 (70 ILCS 2605/57 new) 7 Sec. 57. Nutrient trading. (a) The sanitary district may participate in any available 8 nutrient trading program in the State for meeting water quality 10 standards. (b) The authorization granted to the sanitary district 11 under this Section shall not be construed as modifying or 12 limiting any other law or rule. Any actions taken pursuant to 13 this Section must be in compliance with all applicable laws and 14 15 rules, including, but not limited to, the Environmental Protection Act and rules adopted under that Act.".
