1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1023

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1023 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Central Management Services
5 Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by
6 changing Section 405-525 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 405/405-525)

8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on December 31, 2017)

9 Sec. 405-525. Support Your Neighbor Commission.

10 (a) The Support Your Neighbor Commission is created within
11 the Department of Central Management Services to help increase
12 the number of American and Illinois made products procured and
13 sold by the State.

14 (b) The Commission shall be composed of:

15 (1) one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of
16 Representatives;

1 (2) one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
2 House of Representatives;

3 (3) one member appointed by the President of the
4 Senate;

5 (4) one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
6 Senate;

7 (5) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
8 labor organizations representing manufacturing employees
9 with over 500,000 members;

10 (6) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
11 auto workers' unions;

12 (7) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
13 machinist workers' unions;

14 (8) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
15 garment workers' unions;

16 (9) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
17 statewide business groups representing American
18 manufacturers;

19 (10) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
20 the auto industry manufacturing sector;

21 (11) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
22 the interests of construction equipment and farm implement
23 manufacturing; and

24 (12) one member appointed by the Governor to represent
25 the interests of the American garment industry.

26 (c) In addition to the members listed in subsection (b) of

1 this Section, each of the following, or their designee, shall
2 serve as an ex-officio non-voting member of the Commission: the
3 Director of Central Management Services, the Director of Labor,
4 the Director of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, the
5 Executive Director of the Board of Higher Education, the
6 Secretary of Transportation, and the Director of Natural
7 Resources.

8 (c-5) Members appointed by the Governor, the Speaker of the
9 House of Representatives, the Minority Leader of the House of
10 Representatives, the President of the Senate, and the Minority
11 Leader of the Senate shall be appointed within 60 days after
12 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General
13 Assembly.

14 (d) Appointed members shall serve a term of 4 years. The
15 initial terms for members of the Commission shall commence on
16 January 26, 2015.

17 (e) The members of the Commission shall serve without
18 compensation but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable and
19 necessary expenses, including travel expenses, from
20 appropriations to the Department of Central Management
21 Services available for that purpose and subject to the rules of
22 the appropriate travel control board.

23 (f) Except ex-officio members, the members of the
24 Commission shall be considered members with voting rights. A
25 quorum of the Commission members shall consist of a majority of
26 the members of the Commission. All actions and recommendations

1 of the Commission must be approved by a majority vote of the
2 members.

3 (g) Vacancies occurring among the members shall be filled
4 in the same manner as the original appointment for the
5 remainder of the unexpired term. Members are eligible for
6 reappointment.

7 (h) The Commission shall file a report by December 31 of
8 each year with the Department of Central Management Services.
9 This report shall be posted on the Internet website of the
10 Department of Central Management Services.

11 (i) This Section is repealed on January 31, 2019 ~~December~~
12 ~~31, 2017~~.
