1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Marriage and Dissolution of Marriage Act is amended by changing Section 202 as follows:
- 6 (750 ILCS 5/202) (from Ch. 40, par. 202)
- 7 Sec. 202. Marriage License and Marriage Certificate.)
- 8 (a) <u>The</u> <u>The</u> Director of Public Health shall prescribe the 9 form for an application for a marriage license, which shall 10 include the following information:
- 11 (1) name, sex, occupation, address, social security 12 number, date and place of birth of each party to the 13 proposed marriage;
 - (2) if either party was previously married, his name, and the date, place and court in which the marriage was dissolved or declared invalid or the date and place of death of the former spouse;
- 18 (3) name and address of the parents or guardian of each
 19 party; and
- 20 (4) whether the parties are related to each other and, 21 if so, their relationship.
- 22 (b) The Director of Public Health shall prescribe the forms 23 for the marriage license, the marriage certificate and, when

- 1 necessary, the consent to marriage.
