AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by changing
Section 9-122 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 5/9-122) (from Ch. 121, par. 9-122)

Sec. 9-122. If any person purposely destroys or injures any sidewalk, public bridge, culvert, or causeway, or removes any of <u>the the timber or plank thereof</u>, or obstructs the same, he shall be guilty of a petty offense, fined not more than \$100, and shall be liable for all damages occasioned thereby and all necessary costs for rebuilding or repairing the same.
