Amends the Fireworks Regulation Act of Illinois. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning violations of the Act.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fireworks Regulation Act of Illinois is amended by changing Section 25 as follows:
- 6 (425 ILCS 30/25) (from Ch. 127 1/2, par. 125)
- Sec. 25. Whoever fails to comply with or violates any of the the provisions of the Act shall be guilty of a petty offense, and whoever, after receiving written notice from the Office, or its authorized representative, directing compliance with specified provisions of the Act fails to comply with the provisions of the Act specified in said notice, shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
