2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Public Safety Employee Benefits Act is
5 amended by changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 320/3)

7 Sec. 3. Definition. For the purposes of this Act:⁷

8 "Catastrophic injury" means an injury, the direct and
9 proximate consequences of which permanently prevent an
10 individual from performing any gainful work.

11 "Firefighter" the term "firefighter" includes, without
12 limitation, a licensed emergency medical technician (EMT) who
13 is a sworn member of a public fire department.
