SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

725 ILCS 5/110-14

from Ch. 38, par. 110-14

Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Provides that any person incarcerated on a bailable offense who does not supply bail and against whom a fine is levied on conviction of such offense shall be allowed a credit of \$30\$ (rather than \$5) for each day so incarcerated upon application of the defendant.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is amended by changing Section 110-14 as follows:
- 6 (725 ILCS 5/110-14) (from Ch. 38, par. 110-14)
- 7 Sec. 110-14. Credit for Incarceration on Bailable Offense.
- 8 (a) Any person incarcerated on a bailable offense who does
- 9 not supply bail and against whom a fine is levied on conviction
- of such offense shall be allowed a credit of $\frac{$30}{$}$ for each
- 11 day so incarcerated upon application of the defendant. However,
- in no case shall the amount so allowed or credited exceed the
- 13 amount of the fine.
- 14 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a person incarcerated
- for sexual assault as defined in paragraph (1) of subsection
- 16 (a) of Section 5-9-1.7 of the Unified Code of Corrections.
