SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 5/5 new

Amends the U.S. Constitution Amendment Act. Provides requirements for the selection and duties of delegates to a convention for the proposition of an amendment to the United States Constitution, as provided under Article V of the United States Constitution. Defines terms.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The U. S. Constitution Amendment Act is amended
by adding Section 5 as follows:

(5 ILCS 5/5 new)6 7 Sec. 5. Constitution amendment convention. (a) As used in this Section: 8 9 "Article V application" means an application or resolution passed by the General Assembly applying to 10 11 Congress to call an Article V convention. "Article V convention" means a convention called for 12 the purpose of proposing an amendment to the United States 13 14 Constitution as provided in Article V of the United States

15 <u>Constitution.</u>

16 <u>"Delegate" means an individual elected by the General</u>
17 <u>Assembly, or by any other method provided by law, to</u>
18 represent the State at an Article V convention.

19"Legislative instructions" means instruction given by20the General Assembly to a delegate before or during an21Article V convention.

22"Unauthorized amendment" means a proposed amendment or23change to the United States Constitution that is outside

2	instructions.
3	(b) A delegate from the State to an Article V convention
4	may not act in a manner that supports or approves the proposing
5	of an unauthorized amendment or change to the United States
6	Constitution by the convention.
7	(c) A delegate who violates subsection (b) of this Section
8	is immediately recalled and shall be replaced by an alternate
9	selected by the General Assembly. An alternate selected by the
10	General Assembly has the same duties and is subject to the same
11	requirements and penalties as a delegate selected under this
12	Section.
13	(d) Upon selection by the General Assembly, or by any other
14	method provided by law, a delegate from the State to an Article
15	V convention shall take the following oath:
16	"I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that to the best of my
17	abilities, I will, as a delegate to an Article V
18	convention, uphold the Constitution and laws of the United
19	States of America and of the State of Illinois, and that I
20	will act at all times in accordance with the Article V
21	application and the legislative instructions given to me as
22	a delegate. I will not act in a manner that supports or
23	approves the proposing of an unauthorized amendment or
24	change to the United States Constitution by the
25	convention."
26	(e) The General Assembly shall certify in writing to the

2	(1) the selection of delegates and alternates;
3	(2) if a delegate is recalled, the recall and
4	replacement of the delegate with an alternate; and
5	(3) if a delegate from the State violates subsection
6	(b) of this Section, the nullification of the action that
7	violated subsection (b) of this Section.
