1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2987

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2987, AS AMENDED, by
3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the State
6 Agency Student Worker Opportunity Act.

7 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

8 "Court-involved youth" means an individual who was
9 committed to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice
10 or a county juvenile detention center and has been released
11 from that facility or discharged from custody.

12 "Homeless youth" means an individual up to 21 years of age,
13 who has been verified as a homeless child or youth, as defined
14 under the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act.

15 "Qualified applicant" means an individual who: (1) is 21
16 years of age or younger; (2) is qualified for the internship or

1 student worker position; and (3) is or has been a dependent
2 child in foster care, a homeless youth, or a court-involved
3 youth.

4 "State agency" means all boards, commissions, agencies,
5 institutions, authorities, bodies politic and corporate of the
6 State created by or pursuant to the constitution or statute, of
7 the executive branch of State government.

8 Section 10. Internships and student workers; transmit
9 information.

10 (a) Whenever a State agency has a job opening for an intern
11 or a student worker, that State agency shall notify the
12 Department of Human Services, the Department of Juvenile
13 Justice, and the Department of Children and Family Services and
14 document that notification.

15 (b) The Department of Human Services, the Department of
16 Juvenile Justice, and the Department of Children and Family
17 Services shall take steps to notify qualified applicants of
18 each internship or student worker job opening for which a
19 notification is received under subsection (a) and shall
20 document those steps."
