SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

730 ILCS 5/3-2.5-40.1

Amends the Unified Code of Corrections. Provides that the training for Department of Juvenile Justice personnel shall include courses in restorative justice. Defines "restorative justice". Provides that the Department may adopt rules to implement the training, including the length and frequency of the courses and the curriculum for the courses.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
5 changing Section 3-2.5-40.1 as follows:

6 (730 ILCS 5/3-2.5-40.1)

7 Sec. 3-2.5-40.1. Training. The Department shall design
8 training for its personnel and shall enter into agreements with
9 the Department of Corrections or other State agencies and
10 through them, if necessary, public and private colleges and
11 universities, or private organizations to ensure that staff are
12 trained to work with a broad range of youth and possess the
13 skills necessary to assess, engage, educate, and intervene with
14 youth in its custody in ways that are appropriate to ensure
15 successful outcomes for those youth and their families pursuant
16 to the mission of the Department. The training for Department
17 personnel shall include courses in restorative justice. In this
18 Section, "restorative justice" means a philosophical framework
19 and a series of programs for the criminal justice system that
20 emphasize the need to repair the harm done to crime victims
21 through a process of negotiation, mediation, victim
22 empowerment, and reparation. The Department may adopt rules to
23 implement the training, including the length and frequency of

1 the courses and the curriculum for the courses.
