SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

235 ILCS 5/5-6

Amends the Liquor Control Act of 1934. Provides that grant funds from the Food and Drug Administration for conducting unannounced investigations of Illinois tobacco vendors are deposited into the Dram Shop Fund only until September 29, 2017. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by 5 changing Section 5-6 as follows:

6 (235 ILCS 5/5-6)

Sec. 5-6. FDA grant funds. Grant funds received from the Food and Drug Administration of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for conducting unannounced investigations of Illinois tobacco vendors shall be deposited into the Dram Shop Fund <u>until September 29, 2017</u>.
