Amends the Protection and Advocacy for Mentally Ill Persons Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the Act's purpose.

1 AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Protection and Advocacy for Mentally Ill
- 5 Persons Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (405 ILCS 45/1) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 1351)
- 7 Sec. 1. Purpose. <u>The</u> Governor shall designate an agency
- 8 to administer the protection and advocacy system for mentally
- 9 ill persons, pursuant to the federal Protection and Advocacy of
- 10 Mentally Ill Individuals Act of 1986. The agency shall be
- independent of any agency which provides disability-related
- 12 services (other than advocacy services), including treatment,
- rehabilitation, quardianship or habilitation. The agency may
- 14 receive and expend funds to protect and advocate the rights of
- 15 mentally ill persons.
