1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3536

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3536 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Joliet Regional Port District Act is  
5 amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 1825/15) (from Ch. 19, par. 265)

7 Sec. 15. Appointment of Board. Within 60 days after this  
8 Act becomes effective the Governor, by and with the advice and  
9 consent of the Senate shall appoint 3 members of the Board who  
10 reside within the District outside the corporate boundaries of  
11 the City of Joliet for initial terms expiring June 1st of the  
12 years 1959, 1961, and 1963, respectively, and the Mayor, with  
13 the advice and consent of the City Council of the City of  
14 Joliet, shall appoint 3 members of the Board who reside within  
15 the City of Joliet for initial terms expiring June 1st of the  
16 years 1958, 1960, and 1962, respectively. Of the 3 members each

1 appointed by the Governor and the Mayor not more than 2 shall  
2 be affiliated with the same political party at the time of  
3 appointment. Beginning with the first appointment made by the  
4 Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, after the  
5 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General  
6 Assembly, the Governor must appoint members who reside within  
7 the District outside the corporate boundaries of the City of  
8 Joliet ~~and the Village of Romeoville~~. Within 60 days after the  
9 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 94th General  
10 Assembly, the County Executive of Will County, with the advice  
11 and consent of the County Board, shall appoint 3 members of the  
12 Board for terms expiring June 1st of 2008, 2010, and 2012,  
13 respectively. Within 60 days after the effective date of this  
14 amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly, the President of  
15 the Village of Romeoville, with the advice and consent of the  
16 corporate authorities of the Village of Romeoville, shall  
17 appoint one member of the Board who resides within the Village  
18 of Romeoville for an initial term expiring June 1st of 2016;  
19 and within 60 days after the effective date of this amendatory  
20 Act of the 100th General Assembly, the President of the Village  
21 of Romeoville, with the advice and consent of the corporate  
22 authorities of the Village of Romeoville, shall appoint one  
23 additional member who resides within the Village of Romeoville  
24 for an initial term expiring June 1st of 2021.

25 At the expiration of the term of any member, his or her  
26 successor shall be appointed by the Governor, Mayor, President

1 of the Village of Romeoville, or County Executive of Will  
2 County in like manner and with like regard to political party  
3 affiliation and place of residence of the appointee, as  
4 appointments for the initial terms.

5 All successors shall hold office for the term of 6 years  
6 from the first day of June of the year in which the term of  
7 office commences, except in the case of an appointment to fill  
8 a vacancy. In case of vacancy in the office of any member  
9 appointed by the Governor during the recess of the Senate, the  
10 Governor shall make a temporary appointment until the next  
11 meeting of the Senate when he or she shall nominate some person  
12 to fill such office; and any person so nominated, who is  
13 confirmed by the Senate, shall hold his or her office during  
14 the remainder of the term and until his or her successor shall  
15 be appointed and qualified. If the Senate is not in session at  
16 the time this Act takes effect, the Governor shall make  
17 temporary appointments as in case of vacancies. The Governor,  
18 the Mayor, the President of the Village of Romeoville, and the  
19 County Executive shall certify their respective appointments  
20 to the Secretary of State. Within 30 days after certification  
21 of his or her appointment, and before entering upon the duties  
22 of his or her office, each member of the Board shall take and  
23 subscribe the constitutional oath of office and file it in the  
24 office of the Secretary of State.
