## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 5. - 1 Section 10. The sum of \$980,000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 3 Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with
- 4 administering high school equivalency tests.
- 5 Section 15. The sum of \$2,800,000, or so much thereof as
- 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 7 to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to the
- 8 alternative schools network and other providers for educational
- 9 purposes or bridge programs.
- 10 Section 20. The sum of \$150,000 or so much thereof as may
- 11 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 12 the Illinois Community College Board for support of the P-20
- 13 Council.
- 14 Section 25. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 16 to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and
- 17 Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered
- 18 Nurse Preparation.
- 19 Section 30. The sum of \$60,200, or so much thereof as may
- 20 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 21 the Illinois Community College Board for awarding scholarships

- 1 to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's Challenge Program.
- 2 Section 35. The sum of \$11,697,900, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 4 to the Illinois Community College Board for the City Colleges
- of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

- 7 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the

- 9 appropriated from ICCB Instructional be necessary, is

- 13 Section 75. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
- 14 be necessary, is appropriated from the High School Equivalency
- 15 Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
- 16 associated with administering high school equivalency tests.
- 17 Section 80. The sum of \$12,500,000, or so much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community
- College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois 19
- 20 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and
- 21 conditions associated with the moneys being received, including
- 22 prior year expenditures.

- 1 Section 85. The sum of \$525,000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust Fund
- 3 to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and
- 4 contingency expenses of the Board.
- 5 Section 90. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
- 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult Education
- 7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for operational
- 8 expenses associated with administration of adult education and
- 9 literacy activities.
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 11 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100<sup>th</sup> General
- 12 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
