SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 120/7 new

Amends the Compensation Review Act. Provides that members of the General Assembly are prohibited from receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living adjustment for or during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018. Provides that members of the General Assembly are prohibited from receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living adjustment for terms commencing on or after July 1, 2018, unless otherwise approved by law. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Compensation Review Act is amended by adding
Section 7 as follows:

6 (25 ILCS 120/7 new)

7 <u>Sec. 7. General Assembly COLAs prohibited.</u>

(a) Notwithstanding any former or current provision of this 8 9 Act, any other law, any report of the Compensation Review 10 Board, or any resolution of the General Assembly to the contrary, members of the General Assembly are prohibited from 11 12 receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living 13 14 adjustment, as authorized by Senate Joint Resolution 192 of the 86th General Assembly, for or during the fiscal year beginning 15 16 July 1, 2018.

17 (b) Notwithstanding any former or current provision of this 18 Act, any other law, any report of the Compensation Review 19 Board, or any resolution of the General Assembly to the 20 contrary, members of the General Assembly are prohibited from 21 receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation 22 that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living 23 adjustment, as authorized by Senate Joint Resolution 192 of the HB4274 - 2 - LRB100 15662 RJF 30763 b
