SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Revenue Estimate Act. Provides that the General Assembly shall not enact any bill to appropriate funds within any fiscal year prior to its adoption of a joint resolution reflecting the estimate of funds available for that fiscal year as required under the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability Act. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Revenue Estimate Act.
- 6 Section 5. Passage of appropriation bills prohibited
- 7 before adoption of joint resolution. The General Assembly shall
- 8 not enact any bill to appropriate funds within any fiscal year
- 9 prior to its adoption of a joint resolution reflecting the
- 10 estimate of funds available for that fiscal year as required
- 11 under Section 4 of the Commission on Government Forecasting and
- 12 Accountability Act.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
