1 a child to another state for medical care or treatment if the 2 person responsible for the child's welfare reasonably believes 3 that: 4 (1) the child needs emergency medical care or treatment 5 because of injury or illness; 6 (2) the nearest healthcare facility that is capable of 7 rendering sufficient medical care or treatment for that child's emergency medical condition is not in this State; 8 9 and 10 (3) failure to transport the child to another state 11 will risk further illness or injury to the child. (c) The Department of Children and Family Services may not 12 13 place a child described in this Section in its custody or 14 foster care on the basis that the child is transported to 15 another state under circumstances described in subsection 16 <u>(b).</u>".
