2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by adding
 Section 10-11 as follows:
- Sec. 10-11. Transporting persons under 18 years of age to
 another state for emergency treatment.
 (a) In this Section:
- 10 "Child" means a person under 18 years of age.
- 11"Person responsible for the child's welfare" has the12meaning ascribed to it in Section 3 of the Abused and13Neglected Child Reporting Act.
- 14 (b) A person responsible for the child's welfare may not be 15 criminally liable for a violation of this Article when the 16 person responsible for the child's welfare transports a child 17 to another state for medical care or treatment if the person 18 responsible for the child's welfare reasonably believes that: 19 (1) the child needs emergency medical care or treatment
- 20 <u>because of injury or illness;</u>
- 21 (2) the nearest healthcare facility that is capable of 22 rendering sufficient medical care or treatment for that 23 child's emergency medical condition is not in this State;

2	(3) failure to transport the child to another state
3	will risk further illness or injury to the child.
4	(c) The Department of Children and Family Services may not
5	place a child described in this Section in its custody or
6	foster care on the basis that the child is transported to
7	another state under circumstances described in subsection (b).
