Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 15. The amounts appropriated for repairs and maintenance, and other capital improvements in Section 10 for repairs and maintenance, roof repairs and/or replacements and miscellaneous capital improvements at the Department's various institutions are to include construction, reconstruction, improvements, repairs and installation of capital facilities, costs of planning, supplies, materials and all other expenses required for roof and other types of repairs and maintenance, capital improvements, and purchase of land.

No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from appropriations made in Section 10 of this Article until after

- 1 the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the
- 2 Governor.
- Section 20. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may 3
- be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Juvenile 4
- 5 Justice from the General Revenue Fund for costs and expenses
- associated with payment of statewide hospitalization. 6
- 7 Section 25. The amount of \$194,800, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 9 to the Department of Juvenile Justice for the purposes of
- 10 investigating complaints, evaluating policies and procedures,
- 11 and securing the rights of the youth committed to the Department
- 12 of Juvenile Justice, including youth released on Aftercare
- before final discharge. 13
- 14 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 15 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary,
- appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 16
- 17 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
