| 7  | the contrary, nothing in this Section shall prohibit the       |
| 8  | issuance or renewal of a license authorizing the sale of       |
| 9  | alcoholic liquor at a grocery store at premises located within |
| 10 | a municipality with a population in excess of 25,000           |
| 11 | inhabitants and within 100 feet of a school if:                |
| 12 | (1) the grocery store has been operated continuously by        |
| 13 | the same family since 1956;                                    |
| 14 | (2) the total square footage of the grocery store is           |
| 15 | <pre>less than 19,000 square feet;</pre>                       |
| 16 | (3) the package goods alcohol beverage department of           |
| 17 | the grocery store does not exceed 10% of the total square      |
| 18 | footage of the grocery store;                                  |

| 1  | (4) the sale of alcoholic beverages is not the primary    |

| 3  | (5) the school is a private school with a religious       |
| 4  | affiliation, has been in existence since 1850, and is a   |
| 5  | National Blue Ribbon School on the effective date of this |
| 6  | amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly;             |
| 7  | (6) the entrance to the grocery store is more than 300    |
| 8  | feet from any of the entrances to the school;             |
| 9  | (7) the building in which the grocery store is located    |
| 10 | and the building in which the school is located are       |
| 11 | separated by a large asphalt-paved parking lot and a      |
| 12 | traffic-congested major avenue; and                       |
| 13 | (8) the school board for the school has given written     |
| 14 | permission and consent to the sale of alcoholic beverages |
| 15 | at the grocery store.".                                   |
