AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The sum of \$50,000, or so much of that sum as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Public Health for a grant to the Macon County Coroner for the purpose of conducting autopsies on suspected overdose deaths.
