SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

FY 19 OCE Budget for the Illinois General Assembly.

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
7 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
8 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 4
9 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of their
10 respective houses throughout the year in connection with their
11 legislative duties and responsibilities and not in connection
12 with any political campaign as prescribed by law. Of this
13 amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of the Senate
14 for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated to the
15 Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

16 Section 10. Payments from the sums appropriated in Section
17 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a voucher
18 approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The voucher
19 shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the
20 Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case may be.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$20,603,400, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet the
3 ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate legislative
4 leadership and legislative staff assistants and the House
5 Majority and Minority leadership staff, general staff and
6 office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% is appropriated to the
7 President of the Senate for such expenditures, 25.7% is
8 appropriated to the Senate Minority Leader for such
9 expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
10 House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is appropriated to the
11 House Minority Leader for such expenditures.

12 Section 20. The sum of \$9,882,100, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
14 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
15 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of
16 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem
17 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred
18 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount,
19 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
20 expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
21 House for such expenditures.

22 Section 25. The sum of \$309,200, or so much thereof as may
23 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President

1 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
2 for the ordinary and incidental expenses, also including the
3 purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding,
4 printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House,
5 no part of which shall be expended for expenses of purchasing,
6 handling or distributing such supplies and against which no
7 indebtedness shall be incurred without the written approval of
8 the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of this amount,
9 69.277% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
10 expenditures and 30.723% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
11 House for such expenditures.

12 Section 30. The sum of \$6,483,050, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
14 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees for
15 expert witnesses, technical services, consulting assistance and
16 other research assistance associated with special studies and
17 long range research projects which may be requested by the
18 standing committees and the Speaker of the House of
19 Representatives for Standing House Committees pursuant to the
20 Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 1984. Of this
21 amount, 46.862% is appropriated to the President of the Senate
22 for such expenditures and 53.138% is appropriated to the
23 Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

1 Section 35. The sum of \$167,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President
3 of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for allowances for
4 the particular and additional services appertaining to or
5 entailed by the respective officers of the Senate. Of this
6 amount, 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for
7 such expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Senate
8 Minority Leader for such expenditures.

9 Section 40. The sum of \$88,100, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President
11 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
12 for travel, including expenses to Springfield of members on
13 official legislative business during weeks when the General
14 Assembly is not in Session. Of this amount, 65.5% is
15 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
16 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
17 House for such expenditures.

18 Section 45. The sum of \$341,600, or so much thereof as may
19 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
20 the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent expenses.
21 Any use of funds appropriated under this Section must be
22 approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of Representatives
23 and the Secretary of the Senate.

1 Section 50. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where the
2 approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives is
3 expressly required for the expenditure of or the incurring of
4 indebtedness against an appropriation for certain purchases on
5 contract, "Speaker" means the leader of the party having the
6 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as
7 of January 11, 2017, and "Minority Leader" means the leader of
8 the party having the second largest number of members of the
9 House of Representatives as of January 11, 2017.

10 Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent
12 expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the
13 planning costs, construction costs, moving expenses and all
14 other costs associated with the construction and reconstruction
15 of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.

16 Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the General
18 Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President of the
19 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to meet
20 ordinary and contingent expenses. Of this amount, 50% is
21 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
22 expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Speaker of the

1 House for such expenditures.

2 Section 70. The following named sums, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an appropriation
4 hereto made for such purposes in Section 70 of Article 89 of
5 Public Act 100-0021, as amended, are re-appropriated from the
6 General Revenue Fund for expenses in connection with the
7 planning and preparation of redistricting of Legislative and
8 Representative Districts as required by Article IV, Section 3
9 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

10	To the Senate President	500,000
11	To the Senate Minority Leader	<u>500,000</u>
12	Total	\$1,000,000

13 Section 75. The following named sums, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an appropriation
15 hereto made for such purposes in Section 75 of Article 89 of
16 Public Act 100-0021, as amended, are re-appropriated from the
17 General Revenue Fund for expenses in connection with the
18 planning and preparation of redistricting of Legislative and
19 Representative Districts as required by Article IV, Section 3
20 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

21	To the House Speaker	500,000
22	To the House Minority Leader	<u>500,000</u>
23	Total	\$1,000,000

1 Section 80. The sum of \$441,600, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary and remains unexpended from an appropriation
3 heretofore made for such purposes in Section 80 of Article 89
4 of Public Act 100-0021, as amended, is reappropriated to the
5 Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the
6 planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and
7 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3
8 of the Illinois Constitution on 1970.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
10 1, 2018.
