SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/34-18.60 new

Amends the Chicago School District Article of the School Code. Provides that, each fiscal year, the school board must expend a minimum of \$500,000 on grants for training parents or guardians of students in the school district on the individualized education program process. Requires the training to include a description of the parent's or guardian's rights during the individualized education program process and must engage the parent or guardian in the process. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
5 34-18.60 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.60 new)

7 Sec. 34-18.60. Individualized education program training;
8 grants. Each fiscal year, the board must expend a minimum of
9 \$500,000 on grants for training parents or guardians of
10 students in the school district on the individualized education
11 program process. This training must include a description of
12 the parent's or guardian's rights during the individualized
13 education program process and must engage the parent or
14 guardian in the process.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
16 becoming law.
