1 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, President Donald Trump and Congressional 3 Republicans are proposing radical changes to America's tax 4 code; and 5 WHEREAS, The changes President Trump and his Congressional 6 allies discussing would benefit millionaires are and 7 billionaires while hurting working families; and WHEREAS, President Trump and Congressional Republicans 8 9 have discussed removing the state and local deduction, also 10 known as SALT, as a way to pay for their proposed tax cuts for the wealthy; and 11 12 WHEREAS, The state and local deduction allows families that 13 pay state and local income or sales tax to deduct those taxes 14 from their federal income tax; and 15 WHEREAS, This deduction prevents families from being 16 doubled taxed, once by the federal government and again by the 17 state; and 18 WHEREAS, The state and local deduction has broad bipartisan 19 support and has been helping Illinoisans since 1913; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Illinois has the fifth highest number of taxpayers
- 2 who claim the state and local tax deduction in the nation; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Nearly two million Illinois taxpayers claimed
- 4 more than \$24 billion in SALT deductions in 2015, with each
- 5 claiming an average \$12,500 in deductions; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Of Illinoisans who claim a SALT deduction,
- 7 approximately 85% earn less than \$200,000 per year; therefore,
- 8 be it
- 9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- 10 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE
- CONCURRING HEREIN, that we strongly oppose any and all efforts 11
- 12 by the Trump Administration and Congress to eliminate the state
- and local deduction; and be it further 13
- 14 RESOLVED, That we call upon Governor Rauner to work with
- the Illinois Congressional Delegation to ensure that the state 15
- and local deduction is not eliminated; and be it further 16
- 17 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 18 delivered to all members of the Illinois Congressional
- Delegation. 19
