1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, On May 1, 2017, Great Lakes Basin Transportation, 3 Inc. (GLBT) filed a formal application with the Federal Surface 4 Transportation Board (STB) to construct and operate a private rail line running through Indiana, Illinois, and Wisconsin; and 5 6 WHEREAS, This application calls for a 260 mile privately 7 owned and operated railway that would cut through many 8 individuals homes and farmland; and 9 WHEREAS, The use of eminent domain in our State and our 10 nation is to provide land for public use in appropriate instances, it is not for private gain; and 11 12 WHEREAS, If the plan were imposed in its current form, 13 Grundy County and Kankakee County would lose an estimated \$70 million and \$90 million per year respectively in agricultural 14 15 revenue that could never be replaced; and 16 WHEREAS, The GLBT railway is facing bipartisan opposition 17 from elected officials across three states as well as by certain public railroads; and 18 19 WHEREAS, The GLBT railway improperly damages the rights of

property owners who rightfully own the land in its path,

- 2 and tears apart the communities who depend on that land;

- 4 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- 5 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
- 6 strongly urge against the Great Lakes Basin Transportation,
- 7 Inc. (GLBT) railway due to the fiscal, ethical, and
- 8 environmental strain it would put on the counties this railway
- 9 goes through; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 11 delivered to the Federal Surface Transportation Board.
