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## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The office of the Special Envoy to Monitor and 3 Combat anti-Semitism in the United States Department of State 4 was created in 2004 with bipartisan congressional support and 5 has had the full support of the last two presidents; and

6 WHEREAS, Since 2004, the Special Envoy has helped document 7 abuses against Jewish communities abroad, as well as develop 8 and implement approaches to fight anti-Semitism, filling a 9 major void; the Special Envoy was also able to address specific 10 problems in France, Argentina, Hungary, Ukraine, Greece, and 11 Egypt that might have otherwise not been properly addressed; 12 and

13 WHEREAS, Anti-Semitism is on the rise in the United States 14 and in other nations; and

15 WHEREAS, The position of Special Envoy to Monitor and 16 Combat anti-Semitism is currently vacant and needs to be 17 filled; and

2 against anti-Semitism and for human rights; the Special Envoy
3 has played a unique and important role in this effort;
4 therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 6 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we 7 urge President Trump to fill the position of Special Envoy to 8 Monitor and Combat anti-Semitism and to fully fund and staff 9 the office; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be 11 delivered to President Trump.
