2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Edwin 4 Frederick "Fritz" Goebig II of Springfield, who passed away on 5 October 8, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Fritz was born in the Detroit-area suburbs to
Victor Herbert Goebig and Evelyn Berneice Swartz on Easter
Sunday, April 4, 1953; he graduated from the Punahou School in
Honolulu, the University of Pennsylvania, and the Washington
University School of Law in St. Louis; and

WHEREAS, Fritz joined the Legislative Reference Bureau as a staff attorney in 1980 and developed an expertise in drafting pension legislation that remains unparalleled; he was appointed Deputy Director in 1991 and assumed administrative duties and mentored new drafters in the intricacies of crafting legislative documents; he retired in 2003, but returned to serve the Bureau as a Senior Counsel during legislative sessions until earlier this year, teaching the craft of legislative drafting to a new generation of drafters; and

WHEREAS, Fritz was one of the founding members of the Government Bar Association, an organization that he served tirelessly in a myriad of roles; and
