WHEREAS, Dr. Augsburger began his career with the Illinois College of Optometry in 2002 after serving 30 years in a variety of leadership positions in higher education including as the Interim Provost of the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB), Dean and Professor of the UAB School of Optometry, and Professor of Clinical Optometry at The Ohio State University College of Optometry; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Augsburger has led ICO to more than double its investable assets, resulting in \$40 million dollars in campus renovation and modernization; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Augsburger has been honored by the American Optometric Association as the Distinguished Service Awardee and the National OD of the Year; he has been named Optometrist of the Year in three states; and

- 7 Optometry, the National Board of Examiners in Optometry, and
- 8 the Rotary Club of Chicago, Rotary One, the world's first
- 9 Rotary Club, and as the Immediate-Past Chairman of the
- 10 ROTARY/One Foundation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Dr. Augsburger served on the Special Medical
- 12 Advisory Group (SMAG) of the U.S. Department of Veterans
- 13 Affairs; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Dr. Augsburger served as the 2014-2015 Chairman of
- the Board of the Federation of Independent Illinois Colleges
- and Universities, on the Near South Planning Board of Chicago,
- and on the Jackson Park Hospital Foundation Board; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Dr. Augsburger is a loving husband to wife,
- 19 Stephanie, a proud father, and grandfather to 11 wonderful
