2 WHEREAS, In 1983, President Ronald Reagan designated 3 November as Alzheimer's Awareness Month nationally; and

WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is a neurodegenerative disease that causes a person to progressively lose their memory and overall cognitive function over time; Alzheimer's robs a person of their short-term and long-term memory and has a significant effect on their loved ones; and

WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the most common form of dementia, accounting for 60 to 80% of all dementia cases; dementia is a general term to describe a severe decline in mental ability that interferes with daily life; and

WHEREAS, There are currently 5.7 million people living with
Alzheimer's in the United States, and the Alzheimer's
Association projects that number to grow to 14 million by 2050;
and

WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the 6th leading cause of death in the United States and kills more people than breast cancer and prostate cancer combined; according to the Alzheimer's Association, one out of every three seniors dies of Alzheimer's disease; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Someone in the United States develops Alzheimer's
- or some form of dementia every 65 seconds; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Alzheimer's Association estimates that
- 4 Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia will cost
- 5 people in the United States a combined \$277 billion in 2018;
- 6 they also state that early and accurate diagnosis of
- 7 Alzheimer's could save up to \$7.9 trillion in medical costs;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, No cure is currently available for Alzheimer's
- 10 disease, and the approximate lifetime cost of care for a person
- living with Alzheimer's is \$341,840; therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- 13 HUNDREDTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
- 14 declare November of 2018 as "Alzheimer's Awareness Month"
- within the State of Illinois; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 17 presented to the Alzheimer's Association Illinois Chapter.
