6 WHEREAS, John Lanigan founded Mi-Jack Products from his 7 home in a south suburb of Chicago in 1954; over time, Mi-Jack 8 became a multinational corporation providing machinery and 9 solutions for the transportation and material handling 10 industries worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Early on, Mi-Jack distributed self-propelled 11 12 rubber tired gantry cranes and focused on the railroads and 13 ports of the United States; in the early 1980s, Mi-Jack purchased the manufacturing rights to the cranes it had been 14 15 selling, which helped open up new national and international 16 markets; today, Mi-Jack is recognized worldwide as an industry 17 leader and innovator; corporate headquarters remain in Hazel 18 Crest; in addition, the company maintains four regional 19 operations headquarters, five sales offices, and over 60 intermodal terminals; and 20
