1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 771

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 771 on page 4, by  
3 deleting lines 16 through 20; and

4 on page 6, line 15, after "procedure.", by inserting  
5 "Neurophysiologic intraoperative monitoring does not include  
6 testing and interpretation of test results using  
7 electrodiagnostic modalities to monitor the spinal cord,  
8 peripheral nerves (other than the seventh and eighth cranial  
9 nerve), cerebral hemispheres, or brainstem."; and

10 on page 8, immediately below line 7, by inserting the  
11 following:

12 "(h) The performance of neurophysiologic intraoperative  
13 monitoring of the seventh and eighth cranial nerve by an  
14 individual certified by the American Board of Registration of  
15 Electroencephalographic and Evoked Potential Technologists as  
16 Certified in Neurophysiologic Intraoperative Monitoring only

1 if authorized and supervised by the physician performing the  
2 surgical procedure."; and

3 on page 31, line 6, by replacing "Willfully violating" with  
4 "Violating"; and

5 on page 31, immediately below line 6, by inserting the  
6 following:

7 "(cc) Violating Section 8.3 of this Act."; and

8 by replacing line 14 on page 38 through line 1 on page 39 with  
9 the following:

10 "(b) The terms "audiology", "audiologist", "clinical  
11 audiologist", "licensed audiologist", "speech-language  
12 pathology", "speech-language pathologist", "clinical  
13 speech-language pathologist", "licensed speech-language  
14 pathologist", or any other similar term, title, abbreviation,  
15 or symbol that may indicate that the person is licensed under  
16 this Act shall not be used by any person in any communication  
17 that advertises services regulated under this Act unless he or  
18 she is licensed under this Act as a speech-language pathologist  
19 or an audiologist. An audiologist may".
