15	of the State. A home rule unit may not levy any new taxes or

the capacity to generate electricity by, or the emissions into the atmosphere by electric generating facilities after the effective date of this Act. This Section is a denial and limitation on home rule powers and functions under subsection (g) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution. (b) This Section is repealed on January 1, <u>2021</u> 2019. (Source: P.A. 95-481, eff. 8-28-07.)
