SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

75 ILCS 5/4-10

from Ch. 81, par. 4-10

Amends the Illinois Local Library Act. Provides that a library board of trustees' statement of financial requirements necessary for the next year and any amount the library board believes will be necessary to levy taxes for the library's next fiscal year shall be submitted to the governing board of the municipality no less than 60 days prior to when the tax levy must be certified under the Property Tax Code (rather than 60 days after the expiration of the fiscal year). Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Local Library Act is amended by 5 changing Section 4-10 as follows:

6 (75 ILCS 5/4-10) (from Ch. 81, par. 4-10)

7 Sec. 4-10. Within 60 days after the expiration of each 8 fiscal year of the city, incorporated town, village or 9 township, the board of trustees shall make a report of the condition of their trust on the last day of the fiscal year, to 10 the city council, board of trustees or board of town trustees, 11 as the case may be. This report shall be made in writing and 12 13 shall be verified under oath by the secretary, or some other 14 responsible officer of the board of trustees. It shall contain (1) an itemized statement of the various sums of money received 15 16 from the library fund and from other sources; (2) an itemized 17 statement of the objects and purposes for which those sums of money have been expended; (3) a statement of the number of 18 books and periodicals available for use, and the number and 19 character thereof circulated; (4) a statement of the real and 20 21 personal property acquired by legacy, purchase, gift or otherwise; (5) a statement of the character of any extensions 22 of library service which have been undertaken; (6) (blank); a 23

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1 statement of the financial requirements of the library for the 2 ensuing fiscal year for inclusion in the appropriation of the corporate authority, and of the amount of money which, in the 3 judgment of the board of library trustees, it will be necessary 4 5 to levy for library purposes in the next annual tax levy ordinance; (7) a statement as to the amount of accumulations 6 and the reasons therefor; (8) a statement as to any outstanding 7 liabilities including those for bonds still outstanding or 8 9 amounts due for judgments, settlements, liability insurance, 10 or for amounts due under a certificate of the board; (9) any 11 other statistics, information and suggestions that may be of 12 interest. A report shall also be filed, at the same time, with 13 the Illinois State Library.

The board of trustees of a municipal library shall also 14 submit to the city council, board of trustees or board of town 15 16 trustees, along with the Illinois State Library, a statement of 17 financial requirements of the library for the ensuing fiscal year for inclusion in the appropriation of the corporate 18 19 authority, and of the amount of money which, in the judgment of 20 the board of library trustees, will be necessary to levy for 21 library purposes in the next annual tax levy ordinance. This 22 statement shall be submitted no less than 60 days prior to when 23 the tax levy must be certified under subsection (b) of Section 24 18-15 of the Property Tax Code.

The board of trustees in a township shall also submit its appropriation and levy determinations to the Board of Township SB0851 - 3 - LRB100 05418 AWJ 15429 b

amended.
