Report of lost or stolen firearms. 11 12 (a) If a person who possesses a valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card and who possesses or acquires a firearm 13

- 1 thereafter loses the firearm, or if the firearm is stolen from
- 2 the person, the person must report the loss or theft to the
- 3 local law enforcement agency within 72 hours after obtaining
- 4 knowledge of the loss or theft.
- 5 (b) A law enforcement agency having jurisdiction shall take
- 6 a written report and shall, as soon as practical, enter the
- 7 firearm's serial number as stolen into the Law Enforcement
- 8 Agencies Data System (LEADS).
- 9 (c) A person shall not be in violation of this Section if:
- 10 (1) the failure to report is due to an act of God, act
- of war, or inability of a law enforcement agency to receive
- 12 the report;
- 13 (2) the person is hospitalized, in a coma, or is
- otherwise seriously physically or mentally impaired as to
- prevent the person from reporting; or
- 16 (3) the person's designee makes a report if the person
- is unable to make the report.
- 18 (d) Sentence. A person who violates this Section is guilty
- 19 of a Class C misdemeanor petty offense for a first violation. A
- 20 second or subsequent violation of this Section is a Class A
- 21 misdemeanor.
