The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by 4 5 changing Section 1-123 as follows: 6 (210 ILCS 45/1-123) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4151-123) 7 Sec. 1-123. "Resident's representative" means a person other than the owner not related to the resident, or an agent 8 or employee of a facility not related to the resident, designated in writing by a resident to be his representative, 10 the resident's guardian. "Resident's representative" 11 12 includes: (1) an individual chosen by the resident to act on 13 behalf of the resident in order to support the resident in 14 15 decision-making; access medical, social, or other personal

information of the resident; manage financial matters; or

1	receive notifications;
2	(2) a person authorized by State or federal law,
3	including, but not limited to, agents under power of
4	attorney, representative payees, and other fiduciaries, to
5	act on behalf of the resident in order to support the
6	resident in decision-making; access medical, social, or
7	other personal information of the resident; manage
8	financial matters; or receive notifications;
9	(3) a legal representative, as used in Section 712 of
10	the federal Older Americans Act (42 U.S.C. 3058g); or
11	(4) the court-appointed guardian or conservator of a
12	resident.
13	Nothing in this definition is intended to expand the scope of
14	authority of any resident's representative beyond that
15	authority specifically authorized by the resident, State or
16	federal law, or a court of competent jurisdiction.
