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ARTICLE 99

21 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 22 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General SB2094 -9- OMB100 00006 EMH 10006 b 1 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced

2 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
