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1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	ARTICLE 1
5	Section 1. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6	as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7	hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
8	contingent expenses of the Department of Labor:

- 2 Section 5. "Operational expenses" defined. For the
- 3 purposes of this Act, the term "operational expenses" includes
- 4 the following items:
- 5 (a) Personal Services;
- 6 (b) State contributions to Social Security
- 7 (c) Group Insurances;
- 8 (d) Contractual Services
- 9 (e) Travel;
- 10 (f) Commodities;
- 11 (q) Printing;
- 12 (h) Equipment;
- 13 (i) Electronic data processing;
- 14 (i) Telecommunications services;
- 15 (k) Operation of automotive equipment;
- 16 (1) Refunds;
- 17 (m) Employee retirement contributions paid by the employer;
- 18 (n) Permanent improvements;
- 19 (o) Deposits to other funds.
- Section 10. The amount of \$446,800, or so much thereof as
- 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amusement Ride and
- 22 Patron Safety Fund to the Department of Labor for operational
- 23 expenses associated with the administration of The Amusement
- 24 Ride and Attraction Safety Act.

- Section 15. The amount of \$623,100, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Labor and Day
 and Temporary Labor Services Enforcement Fund to the Department
- 4 of Labor for operational expenses associated with the
- 5 administration of The Child Labor Law Act and the Day and
- 6 Temporary Labor Services Act.
- 7 Section 20. The amount of \$348,300, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Employee
- 9 Classification Fund to the Department of Labor for operational
- 10 expenses associated with the administration of The Employee
- 11 Classification Act.
- 12 Section 25. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
- 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wage Theft
- 14 Enforcement Fund to the Department of Labor for operational
- 15 expenses associated with the administration of The Illinois
- 16 Wage Payment and Collection Act.
- Section 30. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
- 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of
- 19 Labor Federal Trust Fund to the Department of Labor for all
- 20 costs associated with promoting and enforcing the occupational
- 21 safety and health administration state program for public

- 1 sector worksites.
- 2 Section 35. The amount of \$2,970,000, or so much thereof
- 3 as necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Industrial
- 4 Services Fund to the Department of Labor for administrative and
- 5 other expenses, for the Occupational Safety and Health
- 6 Administration Program, including refunds and prior year costs.
- 7 Section 40. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
- 8 necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Industrial Services
- 9 Fund to the Department of Labor for contractual service
- 10 expenses, for the Occupational Safety and Health Administration
- 11 Program.
- 12 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 13 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
- 14 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
