Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1 5 Section 1. 17	Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
18	1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
19	Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
