- 1 Section 5. The amount of \$6,453,500, or so much thereof
- 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 3 Fund to the Office of the Executive Inspector General to meet
- 4 its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 5 2018.
- 6 Section 10. The amount of \$1,610,800, or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public
- 8 Transportation Fund to the Office of the Executive Inspector
- 9 General to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year
- 10 ending June 30, 2018.
- 11 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 12 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
- 13 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
